**An Agreement Between
The University of Connecticut
And
Shetucket Supply Company, Inc**

The University of Connecticut, (hereinafter called the University) and Shetucket Supply Company, Inc (hereinafter called Shetucket Supply) agree to have Shetucket Supply provide plumbing supplies and equipment to the University of Connecticut for consideration by the University to be described later in this agreement, Shetucket Supply will provide the appropriate personnel, materials and equipment necessary for completion of said agreement.

Contract Term: The term of this agreement will be from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2010.

Consideration: Shetucket Supply will provide plumbing supplies and equipment for a markup of cost plus 11% as quoted within their proposal. Payment terms are 2%-20, net 45.

Severability: The parties understand and agree that if a court holds any part, term or provision of this agreement to be illegal or invalid in whole or in part, the validity of the remaining provisions shall not be affected, and parties' rights and obligations shall be construed and enforced as if the agreement did not contain the particular invalid provision.

Entire Agreement: It is mutually agreed by and between the University and Shetucket Supply that this agreement shall create a contract between the parties thereto containing all specifications, terms and conditions. Further the parties agree that the agreement will be the complete expression of the terms and conditions hereunder, including all documents attached by reference. Any oral or written representations or understandings not incorporated in said agreement are specifically excluded.

The University of Connecticut, (hereinafter called the University) and New Britain Supply Company (hereinafter called New Britain Supply) agree to have New Britain Supply provide plumbing supplies and equipment to the University of Connecticut for consideration by the University to be described later in this agreement, New Britain Supply will provide the appropriate personnel, materials and equipment necessary for completion of said agreement.

Contract Term: The term of this agreement will be from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2010.

Consideration: New Britain Supply will provide plumbing supplies and equipment for a markup of cost plus 8.5% as quoted within their proposal. Payment terms are 2%-15, net 45.

Severability: The parties understand and agree that if a court holds any part, term or provision of this agreement to be illegal or invalid in whole or in part, the validity of the remaining provisions shall not be affected, and parties' rights and obligations shall be construed and enforced as if the agreement did not contain the particular invalid provision.

Entire Agreement: It is mutually agreed by and between the University and New Britain Supply that this agreement shall create a contract between the parties thereto containing all specifications, terms and conditions. Further the parties agree that the agreement will be the complete expression of the terms and conditions hereunder, including all documents attached by reference. Any oral or written representations or understandings not incorporated in said agreement are specifically excluded.
